**Requirements for editing and editing articles**

The materials prepared in Romanian, Russian and English are accepted for publication. Total item volume – up to 5 pages, including tables, figures, and charts. Format: A 4. Text editor – Microsoft Word 2003/2007/2010 / XP. Edges: left – 3.0 cm; top, bottom, right – 2.0 cm. Characters type: Times New Roman, 14 pt (in tables – 10-12pt). Space between rows – 1.0. Alineat – 1.0. Arranging text – on the width of the page. Figures and layouts must be black and white, Word editor. References to them are required in the text. The content of the paper should reflect: *actuality; purpose and organization of research; results analysis; conclusions and perspectives for further research*. In the text, you should exclude: complicated figures, horizontal tables, tables on a whole page, highlighted in italics or bold.

**Structure of the publication:** *title of theses* (capitalized, bold, aligned on the center); *author's first and last* (common characters, center alignment); *the name of the organization, city, country* (common characters, center alignment); *keywords* (regular characters, width-of-page layout) *annotation* (max. 7 rows, line characters, page width adjustment); *the text of the publication; reference to bibliographic sources* (maximum 10).

Works that will not be written and completed as required or will be shipped later than the indicated time will not be accepted for publication. The author have full responsibility for the content of the submitted materials.
